

LAST MINUTE INFO

Driving from the Calgary International Airport to Banff

(See reverse for map)

Depart airport via Barlow Trail (head towards Calgary City Centre);

Take 16th Avenue West exit and turn right onto 16th Ave. W.;

Remain on 16th Ave. W. → it becomes the Trans-Canada Highway #1. Continue to head west on the Trans-Canada Highway # 1, pass through the National Park Gates and take the exit for the town of Banff;

Once in Banff, follow the red arrows on the attached Banff map to get to the Banff Centre, *the conference site not the town centre!*

Estimated distance and travel time from A - Airport Rd NE, Calgary to B – Banff Centre, 107 Tunnel Mountain Drive: 141 km – about 1 hour 30 mins.

NOTE: If you are driving your own vehicle (or a rental) you must purchase a National Park Pass for the week. Passes can be bought at the toll booths located at the park gates for \$8.90 per day (per person) or \$17.80 per day (for a car of up to 7 people).

Taking a shuttle bus from the Calgary International Airport to Banff

Once in Banff

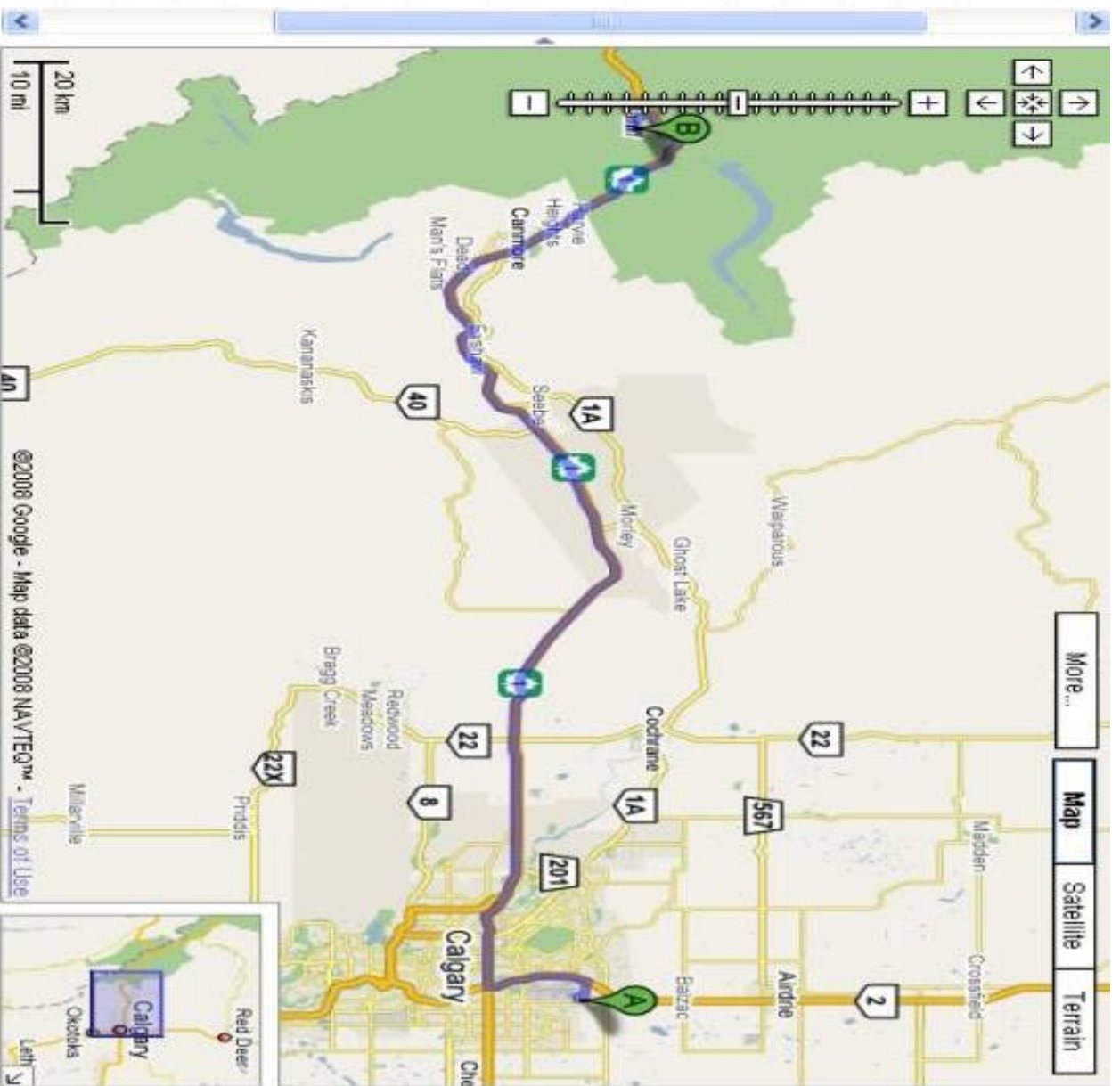
Where do I check in? Go to the Professional Development Centre Reception desk

NOTE: Due to current construction work St. Julien Road, the street that passes through the centre of the property, is closed. To arrive at the Professional Development Centre for check-in, choose Buffalo Street, which connects to Tunnel Mountain Drive. You may reach the parkade directly when coming up St. Julien Road by turning left on Tunnel Mountain Drive.

Parking at the Banff Centre: see the attached Banff Centre campus map for designated parking spots. We recommend that you confirm this information with the staff at the reception desk.

1. Head west on Airport Rd NE 0.2 km
2. Slight right to stay on Airport Rd NE (signs for Arrivées/Arrivals) 62 m
3. Slight right toward 19 St NE 0.3 km
4. Turn left toward 19 St NE 95 m
5. Turn right at 19 St NE 0.4 km
6. Turn left at Airport Trail NE 1.8 km
7. Turn left to merge onto Deerfoot Trail NE S/HWY 2 S 8.0 km
8. Take exit 258 for 16 Ave N West/ HWY-1/16 Ave N East/Trans Canada Hwy 0.8 km
9. Turn right at HWY-1 W/Trans Canada Hwy W 127 km
10. Take the exit toward Banff 0.2 km
11. Turn left at Mt Norquay Rd 1.0 km
12. Continue on Gopher St 0.3 km
13. Slight right at Lynx St 0.1 km
14. Turn left at Wolf St 0.7 km
15. Turn right at St Julien Rd 0.5 km
16. Turn left at St Julien Way 0.2 km
